THE COURSE


DESIGNED BY
KING COLLINS GOLF

INNESS is a beautiful course where walking is encouraged—keeping score and proper attire are optional. The ethos at INNESS is fun, but don't mistake us for being soft. INNESS is designed to play firm and fast.

Wedged between the majestic Catskill and Mohonk mountain ranges, INNESS is a wide-open, inland links-style course with expansive property and mountain views. The nine-hole course was designed by renowned architects and builders King Collins Golf, widely known for creating Sweetens Cove in Tennessee. Absent some of the outdated traditions found at courses of this caliber, INNESS can be enjoyed by golfers of every skill level.

Course designer Collins says “Golfers will know right off that they’re in for something different.” The first thing you’ll see is a massive and wildly undulating 45,000 ft² putting surface that triples as the practice green and the green for the downhill Par 4 second and Par 5 ninth. Another double green combines a reverse Redan on the upper half and a classic “lion’s mouth” bunker framed by the lower half. INNESS will require repeat play to fully appreciate the countless shot-making possibilities.

Connecting fairways that meet massive shared greens, and King Collins’ signature of incorporating architecturally significant elements into modern layouts, will challenge the novice, scratch golfer and pro. You’ll leave here already strategizing how you’ll approach the course when you come back.

THE PROS



Our pros are adept at running any type of game including traditional Match play, Stroke play and Foursome, as well as unofficial games like Scramble and Skins. They're just as adept at introducing newcomers—men, women and juniors of all ages—to the world of golf in a fun and welcoming atmosphere.

JOHN DEFOREST, PGA, HEAD GOLF PROFESSIONAL

John has a lifetime of experience in the golf business. He enjoyed a successful career competing in and winning many local tournaments, long drive events and playing professionally, including appearing in two PGA Championships and one US Open. UNLIMITED GOLF

All Golf members are entitled to unlimited play at INNESS, including complimentary greens fees. Golf members also have access to priority tee times including advance bookings. Hotel guests and the public are only permitted to book within a two week window.

DRIVING RANGE PRIVILEGES

Access to and the condition of a driving range should be one of your top considerations when evaluating a golf club membership. After all, this is where you hone your game. Our driving range is newly built to include a 5,000 ft² Bentgrass Driving Range Tee and hitting area. There are five target flags in the field for aiming and practice sessions. Members can also sharpen their putting skills on our 6-hole 20,000 ft² practice putting green.



MEMBER CLINICS

Member Clinics are complimentary for Golf Members at INNESS. While some clinics will be more structured for experienced golfers to include focus on grip, stance, alignment, putting and driving, clinics are also a great introduction to the game of golf. They're fun to do with friends and great for people who prefer a group learning environment. All clinics are limited to 12 members to allow for dedicated instruction.

DRIVE, CHIP & SIP MEMBER SOCIAL

This one hour clinic includes 30 minutes of focus on a specific aspect of the game like putting, chipping or full swing followed by 20-30 minutes on the course where we practice the specific skill on one to two holes. We wrap up at the Outfitter where participants share a batched cocktail or a beer or glass of wine. Limited to 12 members.





CLUB FITTINGS

Is your equipment right for you? Our Pros can tell you.

The equipment you play with is just as important as your skill level. The clubs you played with ten years ago may no longer serve you, and if you're new to the game it's critical that you're properly fitted for the right set of clubs.

Club fittings are complimentary for all INNESS Golf Members. We currently use a TaylorMade Fitting Cart that includes all available head and shaft specs, but our Pros are also able to recommend alternative brands they know and trust.

Coming in 2023:

Indoor simulator for club fittings; in-house club repair including reshaft and regrip services.

LESSONS




